# Management of BRF Kallkällan

Dec 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022, the assignment at, **Bredablick**, will end. On Jan. 16<sup>th</sup>, **HSB**, takes over our trustee assignment. On April 1<sup>st</sup>, HSB will also take on our property management, hence the current assignment at **Primär** will end March 31<sup>st</sup>. The agreements with HSB are for three years. ## The codes to the entrance doors will be removed

The intercoms are now fixed and all temporary codes for the entrance doors are removed. Residents are advised to use distributed tags to open the entrance door. If for some reason you have not connected your phone to the intercom, you must contact the property manager.

### **Fire safety**

Feel free to light candles in "this dark time" and enjoy the lights and the weekends, but don't forget to put them out when you leave the room or your flat.

Remember that it is the flats owner's responsibility that there are working fire alarms in the flat. Secure that your fire alarm is working by pressing the control button, it should give a sound. If it does not give any sound, change the battery and/or check the age of it. At the bottom of the device, there is usually a sticker with the year of manufacture. Recommended replacement time for fire alarms is every ten years.

## **Christmas Wrapping paper**

It is soon Christmas, and all "nice children" will hopefully get a nice present. Make sure that Christmas wrapping paper and other packaging such as cartons and cardboards are thrown in the container for paper recycling at the recycling station at **Ostkupan**. Christmas gift strings are, however, sorted as residual waste in the ordinary waste bin/"Moluccas".



## **Saving Energy**

The association's energy costs are incresing tremendously and we must all work together to save energy. Gothenburg Energy, which is responsible for both electricity and district heating supplies, warns that they may limit supplies during the winter. Please consider the following:

- Ventilate shortly. Don't leave windows and balcony (incl. glazed balcony) doors open too long
- 2. Take a short shower instead of using the tub
- 3. Do not wash with running hot water. Fully load the dishwasher
- 4. Fill the washing machines. Don't run the tumble dryer/drying room longer than necessary
- 5. Turn off the lighting when leaving basement storage and similar spaces
- 6. Always close the entrance doors
